Family File – Emergency Contact Information

Thank you to all the families who have completed their Family File. All families must update this in [HCPSS Connect](#) each school year. Please check the accuracy for ALL sections of the Family File including address, phone numbers, email addresses, emergency contacts, and emergency dismissal procedures and HIT SUBMIT after each section. This is the most important part of the back to school process!

Absences

Students are to bring in a note after an absence from school. Please include first and last name, reason for the absences, date of absence, and parent signature.

Students are also permitted 3 discretionary absence days a year for family trips, vacations, or other events not associated with the school. You can find the [Extended or Discretionary Absence form here.](#)



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Phone and E-mail Contact - if you have a question that does not require an urgent response, you may call the school to leave a message for your child's teacher, send a note to the teacher, or e-mail the teacher (all e-mail addresses are posted on our school web site) - staff will respond within 48 hours of receipt of your message. If you have an urgent matter, such as change in dismissal procedure or a family crisis situation, please call the school directly rather than sending an e-mail as this will assure that the information is passed to appropriate staff in a timely manner.

This year, all grades at Fulton ES are using a program called **Caring School Community** to help us create an environment where each student feels safe, accepted, encouraged, and happy. The students will also participate in Community Meetings which are discussions to help them get to know each other, solve problems, and become caring, responsible members of the classroom community.

No Dogs Permitted on School Property

As much as we enjoy seeing family dogs at arrival and dismissal, all HCPSS schools are expected to adhere to the following policy:

Animals in schools or offices, leashed or not, present safety, environmental, and liability issues. Students and staff may be exposed to potential physical hazards, such as bites, and/or allergy related health problems. As a result, animals are prohibited within HCPSS buildings. Animals are also prohibited on school system property during arrival, dismissal, recess or other HCPSS sponsored outdoor activities. Service animals or service animals in training per MD Annotated Code Section 7-705 (Service Animals) and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) as well as animals approved for instructional purposes are exempt from this prohibition. Parents who bring dogs on their walks to school must wait for students off school property. We want to ensure the safety of our students as they arrive and leave school. Thank you for adhering to this policy.

From the PE Dept:

All students in grades K – 5 are required to wear sneakers for Physical Education (PE) class. Children should not wear boots, slippers, backless shoes (including backless sneakers), shoes with heels, flip-flops or sandals to PE class because of the safety concern. **To ensure your students' participation in PE class, it may be a good idea to pack extra sneakers on PE days.** Also, please remember that your child should wear clothes appropriate for movement. Wearing skirts, dresses, baggy clothes or loose jewelry can be dangerous and uncomfortable. **Thank you for your understanding that learning in a safe environment is our top priority.**

In case of student injury or illness, parents/guardians will need to adhere to the following physical education guidelines to ensure your child's health and safety. Please send the following documentation to the Health Room:

1. **Write a note** indicating the reason your child needs to be excused from the physical activity portion of PE class for **1-3 consecutive days** (i.e. Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday).
2. Provide a **physician's note** for more **than 3 consecutive days**.
3. Provide a **physician's note** when **returning** from a **long-term illness or injury**.
